


Support mobility options for people who use alternatives to driving alone

TxDOT-supported Public Transportation Programs



- Appx. \$125 million per year in federal and state grant program funds
- Supports programs serving more than a third of the state's population and over 90% of the state's land area
- About 29 million oneway passenger trips per year



TxDOT-Supported Transit Fleet & Facilities

- Over 2500 transit vehicles
- 80 major facilities statewide









Statewide Bicycle and Pedestrian Program



TxDOT 2023 Transportation Alternatives Program Call for Projects

- Schedule Preliminary Application open 12/2/22 1/27/23; 10/23 award
- Available Funding \$250M through FY 2025 for all population areas
- Four Project Categories community-based, large-scale, enhancements, and planning for bicycle and pedestrian infrastructure
- Selection Criteria safety, connectivity, readiness, equity, community support
- Match Options TDCs (economic criteria)
- Outreach webinars (posted online), virtual/in-person workshops (Nov/Dec)


